Attending a private patient appointment at

Chelsea and Westminster Hospital to see Dr Hyer.

Dr Hyer is available to see private fee paying patients at Chelsea and Westminster Hospital on Tuesday and some Wednesdays.

On **Tuesdays mornings or middle of the day**, the clinic is held on level 1 Saturn ward. On entering the hospital, take the escalator to level 1, turn right into Saturn ward. There is a reception desk on the right, explain to the staff you have come to see Dr Hyer privately, and they will direct you to sit outside one of the rooms, usually to the right around the corner beyond the nursing station.

On Tuesday evenings, the clinic is held from 5pm until 6.30pm. This clinic is held on level 1. On entering the hospital, take the escalator to level 1, walk to the back of the hospital to lift bank D, and in the left hand corner, you'll find a large paediatric outpatients area. Check into the reception, informing the staff you have come for a private appointment. I will be working out of clinic room 1 from 5pm.

On **Wednesdays**, the clinic is usually held on level 1 Saturn ward. On entering the hospital, take the escalator to level 1, turn right into Saturn ward. There is a reception desk on the right, explain to the staff you have come to see Dr Hyer privately, and they will direct you to sit outside one of the rooms. Saturn ward is also a NHS surgical admission ward so do not be surprised if there are other patients in the waiting area.
